

## 2024-26 Rolling Work Plan

for the Statement of Intent between

the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) and the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI); the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW); Ministry of the Environment (MOE); and the National Institute of Technology and Evaluation (NITE)
